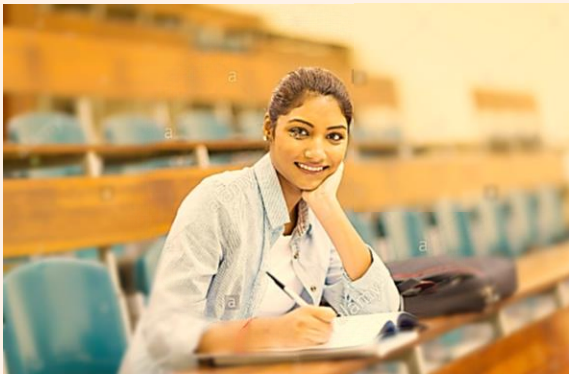


ABOUT YOUTH4JOBS

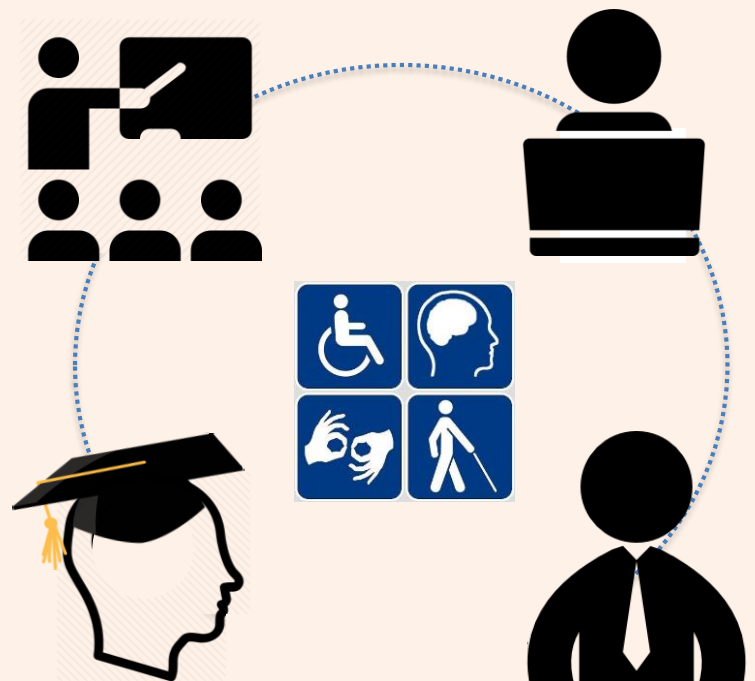

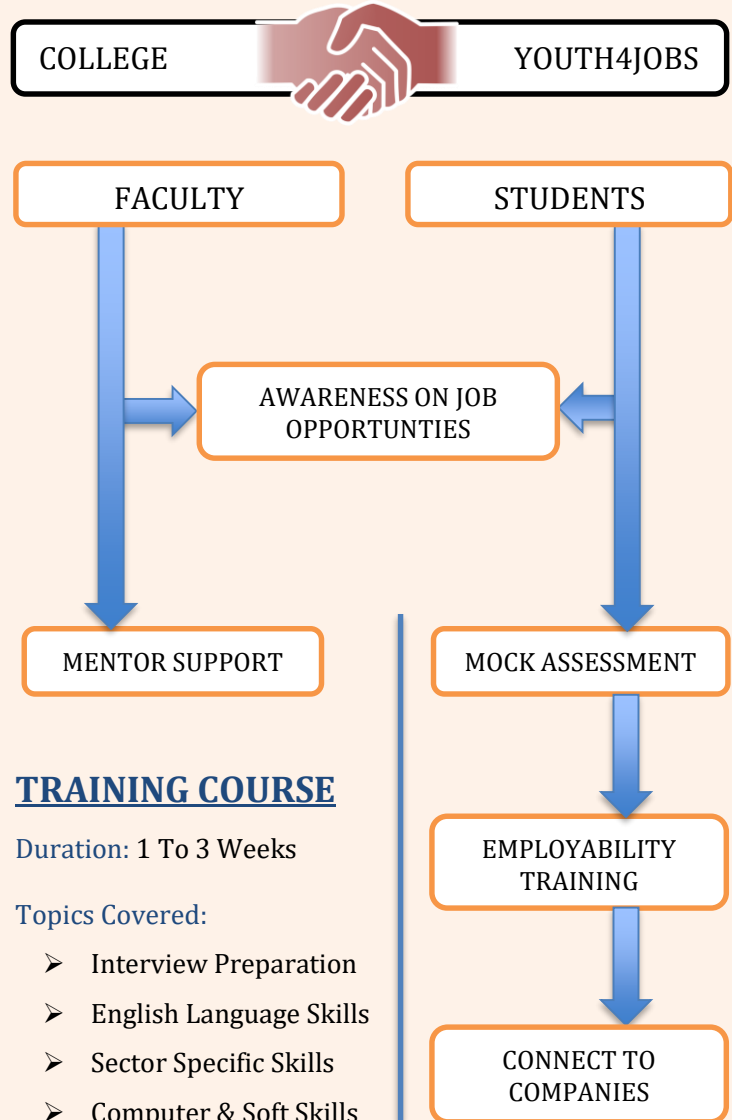
